

Dear Parents,

CTK Preschool Summer Camp Programs are ready! We will have camp for preschool age children 3 to 5, select camps for children who are rising Kindergartners to rising 2<sup>nd</sup> graders and select camps for rising 3<sup>rd</sup> graders to rising 5<sup>th</sup> graders. Children currently enrolled in the 5 day 4s and 4 day 4s are eligible for either 3-5 or K-2 camps and will be placed according to camp enrollment.

Our camps are three fun filled half days which include crafts, games, music, dance and lots of play time! Campers need to bring lunch from home. *Please remember that we are a nut free zone – no nuts or nut products, especially peanut butter.* All camps will run from 9am-1pm each day.

**Week 7 – July 30-August 1 Around the World!** Let's learn some new words, play some new games and cook some new foods from Around the World! (ages 3-5)

**Week 7 – July 30- August 1 Printmaking and stamping!** Campers will try different types of printmaking and stamping, exploring lots of fun processes! (k-2nd) (art)

**Week 8 – August 6-8 Cooking with Books!** Always a favorite with new books and yummy new foods! (ages 3-5)

**Week 8 – August 6-8 Nature** Children will participate in breathing, movement, and mindfulness activities that are nature based (K-2nd) (yoga)

**Week 8 – August 6-8 Printmaking Galore!** Explore different printmaking processes, combine some to experiment and find your printmaking style! (grades 3rd-5th) (art)

Weeks added after May 15<sup>th</sup> to prior registrations will be billed at \$100 each.

Tuition for those enrolled for one to five weeks is payable in full by May 15th. For those enrolled in six weeks or more, tuition may be broken into two payments, the first due by May 15th, 2024 and the second due on or before June 15th, 2024.

All accounts must be current in order to register for summer camp.

Withdrawal: Due to the short duration of the summer program and in fairness to all families who want to enroll, it is expected that once enrolled, withdrawals will not occur. Therefore, once the program begins, no tuition refunds will be made and CTK Preschool expects that parents will abide by the financial commitment made at the time of registration.
