

Summer Art Camp with Miss Caroline!

Camp Week 1: Color My World Dates: June 27,28,29th Ages: 3-5(preschool)

To kick off art camp, campers will get to explore what makes the world so magical... color! How do colors interact to create different moods? What makes a color...pop? We will explore painting with color in many fun and unique ways. Campers will also get to start a colorful collaborative art sculpture for CTK!

Camp Week 2: Fiber Arts Dates: July 18,19,20 Ages: K-2

Campers are going to have a lot of fun diving into the realm of fiber arts (Caroline's personal favorite). Campers will explore weaving, tie dye and fabric dying techniques, stitching, and more. Fiber arts offers many ways for campers to get creative and is a very empowering process for artists of all ages!

Camp Week 3: Paper Art Dates: July 25,26,27 Ages: 3-5(preschool)

A lot can happen with paper and a wild imagination. Campers will make an array of projects with paper, including collaging and lanterns. But wait, there's more! They will also learn how to create their own paper from recycled paper pulp.

Camp Week 4: Sculpture Fun Dates: August 1,2,3, Ages: K-2

Let's lift things off the page and take things 3D at sculpture camp. We will create sculptures with wire, clay, and lot's of recycled materials. Get ready to bend, build, sculpt, and create!

Camp Week 5: Deconstruction Art Books Dates: August 8,9,10th Ages: K-2

Throughout the week campers will create their very own Deconstruction Art Book. They will begin with a book and turn it into a work of art. From cover to cover, campers will explore different techniques of collage, painting, drawing, and printing to make a unique piece of upcycled art.
